

Notice of Race

11th Police World Sailing Championship

1. Introduction

The 11th Police World Sailing Championship will be held from September 11, 2010 to September 18, 2010 in Langenargen/Germany. The participants will live in the Familienferiendorf Langenargen, Rosenstr. 11/1, 88085 Langenargen. You are now invited to participate if you meet the requirements as listed in this Notice of Race.

2. Organisation

The Police World Sailing Championship is organized by the IPA with the support of the regional headquarters of the Baden-Wuerttemberg state police in Friedrichshafen and Konstanz.

3. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as described in the International Racing Rules of Sailing of the IYRU and the additional Sailing Instructions by the race committee.

4. Boats

The organisation will provide the teams with identical „Scholtz 22 Racing“ sailing boats.

The Scholtz 22 measures 6,80 m in length and is 2,50 m wide, has a draught of 1,40 m and a sail area of 29 sqm. It has a genaker of 50 sqm.

The boats will be supplied by a charter company. The boats are identical in construction, but different in age. The teams will draw lots for the boats for every racing day.

5. Eligibility

All active participants should be serving their country's Police or Law Enforcement Agency or they should be honourably retired members.

Each team consists of 3 (4) members, including the helmsman. Before the first race every team has to declare if the team will start with 4 or 3 members. This number has then to be retained for all races.

Each team is allowed to nominate 2 reserve crewmembers. A reserve crewmember may replace a regular crewmember.

6. Entries and Entry Fee for Participants

The entry fee includes:

- accommodation from September 11 to September 18, 2010 (double room)
- breakfast
- lunch packages
- dinner
- boat usage (September 11 to September 17, 2010)
- an excursion day including all meals and admission fees
- competition T-shirt
- fringe events
- festive award ceremony with banquet

The participants are accommodated in the Familienerholungswerk Langenargen, predominantly in nice houses with 2 floors, 3 bedrooms; 2 bathrooms; a kitchen and a small terrace.

7. Non-participants

The entry fee for non-participants (partners, friends, family, etc.) is: **465,--€ p.p.**
The following is included:

- an excursion day including all meals and admission fees
- fringe events
- festive award ceremony with banquet

8. Scoring

The Low point scoring system will apply.

Four races must be completed to constitute a series.

If more than 6 races are held, the lowest score will be discarded.

The organisation reserves the right to change this scoring system if there are more teams than boats.

9. Insurance

The boats are fully insured with a franchise of 1000 € meaning that each crew has to deposit an amount of 1000 € (in cash or credit card) prior to taking over the boat.

If no damage has occurred, the money will be fully recovered or the credit slip will be destroyed.

10. Liability

The organizer reserves the right to further issue more detailed specifications or to postpone or cancel the event. Force major releases the organizers from any liability. The organizer as well as all authorities, organisations and individuals connected with the event cannot be held responsible for any injuries or material damages incurred by participants or guests, before, during or after the event. Whatever a participant does in the event, it is at his own risk, without any exception. By signing his (her) entry form, the participants disclaim the right to sue the organizer, his representatives or any other person connected to the organisation for any damage that might occur. Each participant is fully responsible under civil and/or criminal law for injuries and damages caused by himself (herself) or the boat. By signing the entry form the participants explicitly disclaims appealing to an ordinary court.

11. Binding Application
